ENHANCED RECOVERY AFTER SURGERY

Program: Enhanced Recovery After Surgery is a multimodal and multidisciplinary approach for colorectal and orthopedic surgeries. Key components of ERAS are optimization of medical co-morbidities, effective preoperative patient education, evidence-based peri-operative care within a multidisciplinary team, non-opioid multimodal analgesia, early mobilization and discharge.

Objectives: After this session, the participant will be able to:

- 1. Describe the extent of the opioid epidemic, the role of opioids in pain management after surgery, and best practices to improve prescribing opioids.
- 2. Explain the purpose, identify the components, and describe the goals of an ERAS program.
- Understand the role of the anesthesia provider during the preoperative, intraoperative, and postoperative periods of an ERAS program.
- Describe the post-operative respiratory therapy assessment for ERAS, identify post-operative respiratory complications, and summarize oxygenation and lung expansion treatment strategies.
- Understand occupational therapy's role in ERAS, instruct in activities of daily living, identify appropriate use of adaptive equipment and recommend home set up.
- Understand physical therapy's role in ERAS, describe how to effectively mobilize patients, identify characteristics for early discharge or factors that lengthen stay.
